Item 2. Accepted Apologies

Item 4. Discuss the Application for recognition of Asset of Community Value

The application of The Three Turns Inn as an Asset of Community Value was first discussed in
2014. No planning application has been submitted for change of use.

Following discussion with Cllr. R. Bell, the Parish has been informed that an application can
be submitted for recognition of the Three Tuns Inn as an Asset of Community Value.
Submission of an application was proposed by Cllr. W. Greenfield and seconded by R.
Hutchinson. Cllr. M. Souter abstained from the vote as he did not agree with the motion. All
remaining in agreement.

P. Fraser informed the meeting that a separate application is in the process of being
submitted in collaboration with other parish residents.

5. Village Green Tree Inspection

Christmas Tree Lights

Mr D. Hutchinson informed the meeting that the Carnival Committee had ceased to use
screws to fit Christmas tree lights and that most of the trees now had lights wrapped around
instead. Lights were also left on the trees unless this created a problem.

Tree Inspection

A tree inspection was last done in 2018. The costs provided by John D Alderson from DCC for
a general and detailed inspection was discussed. The costs for a detailed inspection were
found to be prohibitive and it was agreed that a general inspection would be undertaken
initially due to the short time frame before nesting.

It was agreed that Cllr. R. Hutchinson and Cllr. M. Souter would be present when Mr
Alderson comes to inspect the trees on the 24th March 2022.
